Use of Our Time

A recent study revealed that an average seventy-year old man has spent twenty-five years sleeping, fourteen years working, eight years in amusements, six years at the dinner table, five years in transportation, four years in conversation, three years in education, and two years in studying and reading.

His other four years were spent in miscellaneous pursuits. Of those four years, he spent forty-five minutes in church on the Sundays he did attend, and five minutes were devoted to prayer each day whenever he prayed. This adds up to an unimpressive total of five months that he gave to God over the seventy years of his life. Even if this man had been a faithful churchgoer who attended Sunday school and three one-hour services per week, he would have spent only one year and nine months in church during his life!
